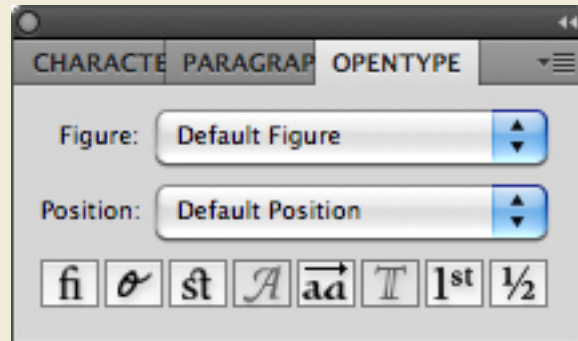


Read Me First!

Setting beautiful copy with Steinweiss Script is very easy, but there is one rule that you really need to follow for this font to set properly.



Absolutely

The "cardinal" rule that must always be followed when typesetting this font is that the **Standard Ligatures** and **Contextual Alternates** buttons in the OpenType palette must be pressed. The difference can be seen here in the two samples. Above, without those buttons being pressed, the text is missing the "Ab" ligature, and the final "y" isn't the one designated for ending words. Below, with those two buttons pressed, the sample sets correctly with ligature and alternate character.
