
Read Me First!

Setting beautiful copy with Metroscript is very easy, but there is one rule that you really need to follow for this font to set properly.

The "cardinal" rule that must <u>always</u> be followed when typesetting Metroscript is that the Standard Ligatures and Contextual Alternates buttons in the OpenType palette <u>must</u> be selected. See the difference in these two samples. Above, without those buttons being selected, the text is missing both the "Ex" and "ti" ligatures, and the final "n" isn't the one assigned for word endings. Below, with those two buttons selected, the sample sets properly with correct ligatures and alternate character.
