Centima Mono is a subfamily addition to *Centima* type family.

Centima Mono is a condensed geometric monospaced sans serif, built in six styles. The typeface is intended for use in display sizes, but also is quite legible in text and is well suited for editorial and brand design.

Centima Mono is released in OpenType format with support for most European languages and includes some opentype features.

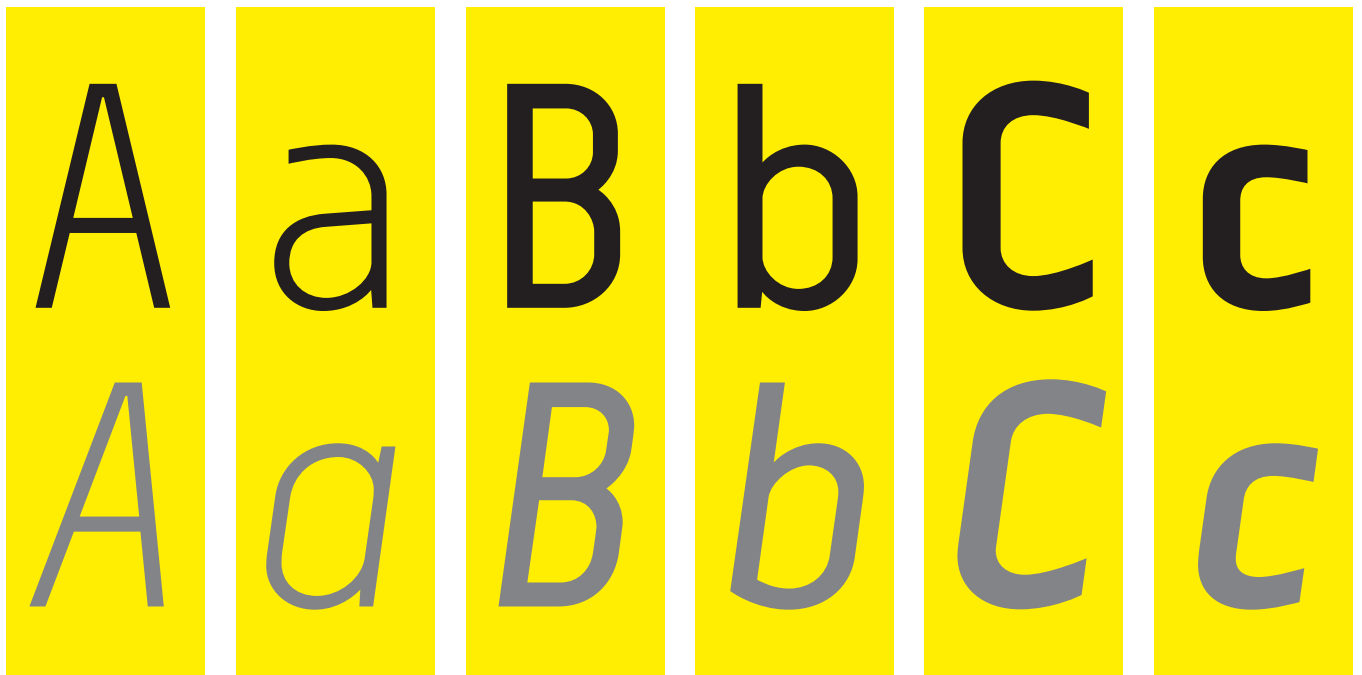
