


Read Me First!

Beautifully set copy with Deliscript is very easy, but there is one rule that really needs to be followed for this font to set properly:



Brisket

The "cardinal" rule that must always be followed when typesetting Deliscript is that the **Standard Ligatures** and **Contextual Alternates** buttons in the OpenType palette must be pressed. The difference can be seen here in the two samples. Above, without those buttons being pressed, the lowercase "r" is incorrect, as is the ending lowercase "t". Below with those two buttons selected, note that the sample sets correctly with the proper characters.
