

AN OVERVIEW OF OPENTYPE LAYOUT FEATURES

OpenType layout features provide the user with integrated access to certain typographic refinements — like small caps, alternate figure styles, or stylistic variants — without changing fonts or disrupting the underlying text encoding. Note, however, that some features may not be accessible or supported in all applications. Please consult your software’s user guide for details.

The TRILBY OpenType fonts include the following features:

OLDSTYLE FIGURES – Replaces default lining figures with figures suited for use in text settings; also replaces currency symbols, math symbols, ¤, §, %, and ‰.

FRACTIONS – Replaces arbitrary fraction sequences with properly sized and positioned numerators & denominators.

1 1/2 31/64 1/100th ▶ 1 ½ ⅓ 1/100th

SUPERIOR – Replaces figures with properly scaled and positioned superscript figures. Also replaces daggers with superscripted variants.

noted² cited[†] ▶ noted² cited[†]

INFERIOR – Replaces figures with properly scaled and positioned scientific inferiors.

H₂O C₆H₁₂O₆ ▶ H₂O C₆H₁₂O₆

SLASHED ZERO – Replaces the figure zero with a slashed variant.

LIGATURES – Replaces the following combinations with f- and ff- ligatures.

fi fl ff fj ft ffi ffl ▶ fi fl ff fj ft ffi ffl

CONTEXTUAL ALTERNATES (NON-KERNING F) – Replaces an f followed by certain ascenders and diacritics with a non-kerning variant to avoid collisions.

fb fh fk fi fi fi fi ▶ fb fh fk fi fi fi fi

DISCRETIONARY LIGATURES – Replaces the www sequence with a single ligature.

CASE PUNCTUATION – When ALL-CAPS styling is applied, parentheses, brackets, braces, dashes, guillemets, and Spanish opening question and exclamation marks are replaced with shifted forms.

STYLISTIC SET 1 (SINGLE-STORY FORMS) – Replaces default forms of lowercase *a* and *g* with single-story versions.

agreeable garbage ▶ agreeable garbage

STYLISTIC SET 2 (BARRED A) – Replaces default form of capital *A* with alternate version with top bar.

QUAINT THÉÂTRE ▶ QUAINT THÉÂTRE

STYLISTIC SET 3 (LOOPED Q) – Replaces default form of capital *Q* with alternate version with a looped tail.

QUAINT Questions ▶ QUAINT Questions

STYLISTIC SET 16 – Replaces default forms of asterisk and registered mark with larger, lowered forms.

*asterisk ®registered ▶ *asterisk ®registered

STYLISTIC SET 17 (SHORT F) – Replaces all instances of lowercase *f* with the short, non-kerning form.

free fulfilling falafels ▶ free fulfilling falafels

STYLISTIC SET 18 (NOMINAL DASHES) – Replaces default forms of em and en dashes with full-measure nominal forms without sidebearings.

en– & em—dashes ▶ en– & em—dashes

STYLISTIC SET 19 (PRIMES) – Replaces default forms of straight quotes with angled prime marks.
